CUI's Mass Emergency Notification System:

The University's an emergency notification system is powered by Titan HST. As a guest at Concordia, you can receive alerts pertaining to campus emergencies through your cell phone via text message. In order to receive emergency alerts while on campus, please scan the **QR code on the right or text "sub cuivisit" to 848261**.



Campus Visitation After-hours:

All persons visiting the campus after hours between 9 PM and 6 AM must be authorized and called-in. If you are expecting a visitor after hours, please contact Campus Safety at (949) 214-3000 with the name and time of arrival of your visitor. Please be prepared to provide your name and room assignment. All visitors' names and vehicles will be recorded upon entry after hours.



Parking at CUI:

- Please park in designated participant parking lots. Gatehouse attendants can assist with direction.
- Oversized vehicles such as RVs are not permitted on campus. A parked vehicle must fit in a single parking stall. Accommodations will be made for school buses.

CUI Alcohol and Drug policy prohibits:

- Unauthorized possession or use of alcoholic beverages.
- Illegal possession or use of drugs including recreational and medical use of marijuana.
- Individuals who are obviously under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Driving on campus while under the influence of alcohol or drugs at any Blood Content Level.

Gun and other Weapons Laws and polices:

Concordia University Irvine is committed to maintaining a safe and secure environment that supports the academic mission of the University. According to State Law and Concordia University Irvine Firearms and Weapons Policy, all persons, including Concordia University students, faculty, staff, and visitors, are prohibited from possessing firearms or weapons of any kind. Weapons include but are not limited to knives with a fixed blade over 2.5 inches (other than kitchen knives), slingshots, bows and arrows, metal knuckles, hunting equipment, razors (does not include cartridge razors for shaving), stun guns, paintball guns, BB guns, and air pistols.

Note: This state law pertains to all K-12 campuses along with all colleges and universities.
